Making a nomination

A nomination should be for a person who has made an outstanding contribution to the cause of oral history in Australia over a considerable period of time. Activities to be considered when preparing the nomination include:

- **Promotion and raising of awareness** of oral history, within the oral history profession, with historians, with organisations and within the general community.
- **Volunteer work** with communities, not-for-profit groups and with oral history associations.
- **Initiation** of oral history projects **and contribution** to oral history projects documenting Australia's past and contemporary history.
- **Recording and documentation** of oral history.
- **Preservation and archiving** of oral history collections.
- **Research** involving assessing oral history.
- **Publication of papers**, journal articles and books.
- **Education and / or teaching** including conduct of seminars, workshops.
- **Mentoring.**
- **Activity in paid employment** or as a professional consultant.
- **Such other contributions** to oral history considered worthy of recognition.

A nomination:

- should present a persuasive case addressing where applicable, each of the above activities under the relevant heading, setting out the significance of the achievements of the nominee; while the nomination should be succinct, it may be up to three A4 pages in length;
- shall be type-written on the prescribed form and marked 'Confidential';
- must be signed and dated by the nominator;

- may be made by any member of a State oral history association or resident of Australia; there is no impediment to a person nominating themselves.
- a self nomination should include the names and addresses of two people who know the nominee’s work and to whom the judging panel could refer, if necessary.
