Associate Professor Carol Liston

The Annual History Citation, awarded by the History Council of NSW, recognises and honours an individual who has made a significant and lifelong contribution to the profession and practice of history. For 2016 the History Council of NSW is pleased to award the Annual History Citation to Associate Professor Carol Liston, in recognition of her contribution to researching and teaching history and heritage, and her service to community and local history organisations.

Carol Liston is an Associate Professor at Western Sydney University and has been teaching history there for over 25 years. She completed her PhD at the University of Sydney and specialises in the history of early New South Wales. Since 1983, she has served on the Council of the Royal Australian Historical Society and was awarded a Fellowship in recognition of her many years of service. She has been involved in community and local history for many years in Parramatta, serving as a member of the Parramatta City Council Heritage Advisory Committee and Trustee of the Parramatta and District Historical Society.

Associate Professor Liston is also an expert on Parramatta's Female Orphan School, and has been dedicated to its restoration and adaptive re-use. Her published works include histories of Campbelltown, Parramatta and Liverpool, biographies of Sarah Wentworth and Thomas Brisbane, accounts of social life under Governor Macquarie, and the convict women of the Parramatta Female Factory.

The History Council of NSW is honoured to celebrate Associate Professor Liston's achievements.
