



Minutes: Annual General Meeting

History House, 5.30pm-6.30pm, 24 February 2017

1. Welcome and Apologies

Meeting commenced at 5:30

2. Declaration by Returning Officer

Nicole Cama read the Returning Officer's report for the nominations for the History Council of NSW's (HCNSW) 2017-18 General Council. Fifteen nominations were received; 12 for corporate representatives and four for individual representatives.

Christine Yeats nominated Mari Metzke as an individual representative, which was seconded by Tanya Evans. No other nominations were received from the floor. There are four vacancies on the 2017-18 General Council as sufficient nominations were not received.

David Carment proposed approaching others to nominate and for the final four councillors to be appointed at the first General Council meeting for the year. This was seconded by Christine Yeats.

Andrea Fernandes suggested the HCNSW consider making a spot available on the General Council for a 'youth representative'. Richard Neville suggested approaching the Australian Museum in relation to the Indigenous Representative on the Council.

3. Minutes from previous Annual General Meeting (attached)

Richard Neville moved that the minutes be accepted, seconded by Mari Metzke. Motion carried.

4. President's report

Tanya Evans referred to the President's report on page three of the Annual Report 2016. Nancy Cushing requested an update on the funding situation for the HCNSW. Nicole Cama reported that

the 2016 project funding received from Arts NSW was specifically for History Week 2016. However, the HCNSW's successful application for 2017 program funding has ensured the HCNSW has increased funds from \$60,000 to \$80,000 which will fund a range of activities in 2017. In addition to Arts NSW funding, the HCNSW staff and President are currently exploring further funding opportunities.

University of Wollongong was suggested by Nancy Cushing and David Carment as a possible contributor to the General Council and collaborator for the HCNSW's 2017 program.

David Carment moved the adoption of the report, seconded by Andrea Fernandes. Motion carried.

5. Treasurer's Report

Richard Neville referred to page 13 of the Annual Report 2016. He noted the HCNSW ended 2016 on a positive note with a \$10,493 surplus and with the increase in funding for 2017, is now in a good position to move forward with its new programs. He acknowledged the efforts of Nicole Cama in keeping a close eye on spending and maximising the HCNSW's resources.

Lisa Murray moved the adoption of the report, seconded by Nancy Cushing. Motion carried.

6. Annual Report

Megan Martin noted her name was missing from the Annual Report 2016.

Action: Nicole Cama to amend the report to include Megan Martin.

Tanya Evans and Louise Trott highlighted the report's clear and well presented new look. Nicole Cama noted the reason for the more succinct and cleaner look was so the report could function not just as a report to members but as a promotional document for funding bodies.

7. Nomination of an auditor for 2017 financial year

Stirling International were appointed the new auditors for the HCNSW in 2016. Nicole Cama reported the auditors were professional and very efficient and that she would highly recommend the members present consider Stirling International be approached to undertake the 2017 audit.

Mari Metzke moved that Stirling International be approached to undertake the HCNSW's 2017 audit, Richard Neville seconded. Motion carried.

8. Other business

Nancy Cushing said the Australian Historical Association Conference (3-7 July) call for papers is open until the end of March. David Carment mentioned he has approached other history councils to participate in a history council session.

David Carment - the 2017 NSW Premier's History Awards will open on 27 February 2017.
