Zoom Meeting & Webinar

Live Streaming: a broadcast of the video and sound of an event over the internet as it happens.

More examples

- *You can watch a live stream of the event from our website.*
- *We will offer a live stream of the conference online.*
- *Some people might not want to appear in the live streams.*

Examples of platforms that live-stream:

- Zoom/Skype, etc
- YouTube
- Facebook
- Vimeo

Recording: recording of an event from within the video platform (Zoom/Skype. etc). Gives the organisers greater control over the end product. Can then be edited and uploaded to a website/YouTube channel afterwards.

Difference between a Zoom Webinar and a Meeting:

A standard Zoom meeting is fully interactive and allows all participants the ability to see, speak, hear, and screen-share with each other. A Zoom webinar can be created as a view-only platform where the attendees cannot see each other, and the Host cannot see the attendees. (These settings can be changed in the background).

Differences also depend on the type of subscription you have. (See Zoom Protocols sheet)
